Dear Parents and Students:

It is with great excitement that I announce the start of the classrooms addition and band renovation/addition projects! Construction for NPHS projects will begin October 17, 2017 and are expected to finish Mid-September 2018. During this construction, we will make every effort to ensure that the day to day operations of school are not interrupted. All construction areas will be fenced off and constant monitoring will take place to ensure the safety of all parties.

Some modifications to our normal routine will be necessary in order for things to transition smoothly. As adjustments to our normal routine are made, students and parents will be informed and given instructions. At present, the primary change for NPHS will be traffic flow. Traffic flow for student drivers as well as student drop off and pick up will need to be modified. I have outlined below the changes to be made and have attached a map to this letter. This letter and the attached map will also be posted on the school website.

Traffic route modifications:

Student drivers:

Beginning Tuesday, October 17th all student drivers must enter and exit through the west entrance off Horace Holmes Road. The west entrance will remain open during the day. Only student vehicles are allowed to enter and exit from this entrance. Failure to follow routing instructions or good driving practices will result in loss of driving privilege.

Student pick up/drop off:

Beginning Tuesday, October 17th all students who are dropped off and/or picked up will do so through the circle entrance on the north side of campus. This entrance is one way and students will not be dropped off or picked up in any area except at the front awning. Parents should ensure that students follow procedures to reduce the likelihood of an accident.

These routing modifications will last for the duration of construction. Traffic flow will revert to normal once all projects have ended. I would like to thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation while renovations take place. The end result will be well worth the effort.
